SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

Fused Glass– You will learn about the properties of glass, tools and equipment, safety, manipulation of glass, and finishing fused glass.

Watercolor– Learn the techniques of traditional watercolor painting.

Collage –Have fun with collage and learn some new techniques for backgrounds, textures, and ways to make your collages really shine. We will experiment with stencils, paints and more.

Felting – With a specialized needle, we will bond wool fibers into a small felted work of art.

Basket Weaving – Make a simple basket. This beginner basket is easily shaped using twining and weaving techniques. You will also learn a simple border for finishing.

Weaving on the floor looms – Learn how to weave on our floor looms. Weave a simple project with information you will be able to take back to your classroom.

Ceramics – Slip and Slab – Learn how to construct a simple slab or coil project.

Chain maille – This class will introduce you to chain maille. Chain maille is created by linking metal rings in a pattern. Modern Chain maille is used to make jewelry. We will discuss tools and techniques and use them to make a finished chain maille project. This is fine work so bring your favorite magnifier if you need it.**
