
All courses are 3 credit hours. This rotation provides 18 credit hours to fulfill State requirements for the Reading Teacher endorsement.

State of Illinois Endorsement Requirements

The courses listed to the left address all six key areas required by the state, as well as the required clinical hours and practicum.

In addition to required coursework, candidates must pass ILTS content test #222 - Reading Teacher.

Teachers who wish to earn a Master's degree with the Reading Teacher endorsement may complete the 18 hours listed at left, 12 additional hours (RDLT 54400, 52700, 57500 & EDLD 55700 or RDLT 54700), the comprehensive exam for the M.Ed. degree, and the ILTS content test #222 – Reading Teacher.

To qualify as a Reading Specialist, teachers must complete the 18 hours listed at left and additional hours in State-approved specialist coursework for the Master of Arts degree (39 hours total). Candidates must also pass a comprehensive examination for the MA degree & ILTS content test #221 - Reading Specialist.
