The DuPage School EC Network is back by popular demand! Please join us on February 15 along with Dr. Elliot Regenstein who will provide ESSA P-2 updates. The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires states to have a measure of school quality in their accountability system. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has chosen to include a measure of P-2 quality which emphasizes the importance of those years. ESSA has strict requirements for indicators to be included in the formula. To this end, ISBE created the P-2 Indicator Working Group charged with recommending an indicator or indicators to place weight on the P-2 years in Illinois' accountability formula. Dr. Elliot Regenstein, an acting member of the ISBE's P-2 Indicator Working Group will provide an update of these recommendations at our meeting. Read more.
