Autism Course in Addison:

Spanish for Teachers Courses:

TIDE will be offering Spanish I For Teachers this spring. These courses are designed to help teachers support students and parents who may know little or no English. Bilingual Endorsement:

TIDE and University of St. Francis will be offering the course required for ESL teachers to complete their bilingual endorsement. Since this endorsement requires a target language proficiency assessment, there is a lower incidence of area educators who might qualify. As a result, the course is not offered as frequently as others.

LBS1 Approval for ESL endorsed teachers - three course program begins 1/16/18:
