DuPage's Regional Spelling Bee takes place on Thursday, **Feb. 19, 2026**, at Hubble Middle School in Warrenville. Registration is at 5:30 p.m., and the Bee begins at 6 p.m.

S-T-U-D-Y

The Regional champion registers for Bee Week and starts studying for the national competition in Washington, D.C.

N-A-T-I-O-N-A-L-S

In May, Regional Champions travel to D.C. to take part in Bee Week. A National Champion is declared during a nationally-televised live broadcast.
